## Star

## Jistols loaded with five rounds each HDEC holstered

Start with hands on hips
ATB: Using your pistols shoot all the plates off the star. Any remaining rounds dump on the dump target.

## SPEED RIFLE

Rifle loaded with 10 rounds HDEC staged on bar

Start with hands flat on table
ATB: Shoot the rifle targets and P/R target in a double tap sweep starting on either outside target.

Additional attempts may be made, but you must wait your turn

## SPEED PISTOL

## Both pistols loaded with five

 rounds each HDEC, holstered
## Start with hands on holstered pistols

## ATB: Shoot a 3-4-3 sweep starting on either end.

Additional attempts may be made, but you must wait your turn

## POCKET PISTOL

- Pocket Pistol loaded with 5 rounds
- Start standing behind table with one hand on timer, pocket pistol in other hand, muzzle touching table.
- Start timer yourself
- ATB shoot a Nevada Sweep starting on either end
- A miss is a 5 second penalty
- You may shoot as often as you want unless someone is waiting


## DERRINGER

- Derringer loaded with 2 rounds
- Start standing behind table with one hand on timer, derringer in the other hand muzzle touching table.
- Start timer yourself
- ATB shoot middle target 2 times
- A miss is a 5 second penalty
- You may shoot as often as you want unless someone is waiting


## STRING SHOOT

## Three shots from the rifle to cut the string.

Award will be given to the one who cuts the string in the shortest amount of time.

## SPEED SHOTGUN 6+

Start with shotgun flat on left end of bar.

ATB: Knockdown the two shotgun targets - THEN move to the other side of barkeep and knockdown the two shotgun targets - THEN - move to the barrel and knockdown the remaining two shotgun targets.


## Long Range <br> (50 \& 100 Yards)

## Equipment Needed:

- 50 yards - 2 SA pistols loaded with 5 rounds each holstered HDEC
- 100 yards - Lever Action rifle (or other pistol caliber cowboy rifle) loaded with 10 rounds - HDEC

Procedure for 50 yards (pistols) and 100 yards (rifle):

- Shooter will load pistols and rifle at the loading table and approach the firing line when instructed.
- If starting with pistols:
- Pistols will start holstered with hands at your sides
- If starting with rifle:
- Rifle will be held at port arms
- Shooter will state which color target (red or blue) they prefer to engage.
- Hits on targets is the primary score - if a tie, time spent will be used.

ATB:

- Shooter will engage the targets (pistol or rifle) at their chosen speed.
- Shooter may ask for feedback on their shots if needed.

Additional attempts may be made, but you must wait your turn.
